Short-term post hospitalization housing	Short-term post hospitalization Housing provides those who do not have a residence, and who have high medical or behavioral health needs, the opportunity to continue their medical, psychiatric, or substance use recovery immediately after exiting an inpatient institutional setting. The setting must provide individuals with ongoing supports necessary for recuperation and recovery such as gaining the ability to perform activities of daily living (ADL's), receive necessary medical/psychiatric/substance use disorder care, and other supports necessary to safely and effectively recover. Respite Services	Respite Services are short-term services provided to caregivers of those who require occasional temporary supervision to give relief to the caregiver. Day Habilitation Programs	Day Habilitation Programs provide services in or out of a person's home to assist them in acquiring, retaining, and improving self-help, socialization, and adaptive skills necessary to reside successfully in the community. 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Nursing Facility Transition	Nursing Facility Transition helps individuals live in the community by facilitating transitions from a nursing facility back into a home-like, community setting, such as an Assisted Living Facility.	Individual has resided 60+ days in a nursing facility, willing to live in an assisted living setting as an alternative to a Nursing Facility, and able to reside safely in an assisted living facility with appropriate and cost-effective supports. Sobering Centers	<p>Sobering Centers are used as alternative destinations for individuals who are found to be publicly intoxicated and would otherwise be transported to the emergency department or jail.</p> <p>Sobering centers provide services such as medical triage, lab testing, a temporary bed, rehydration and food service, treatment for nausea, wound and dressing changes, shower and laundry facilities, substance use education and counseling.</p>	Individuals ages 18 and older who are intoxicated but conscious, cooperative, able to walk, nonviolent, free from any medical distress (including life threatening withdrawal symptoms or apparent underlying symptoms), and who would otherwise be transported to the emergency department or a jail or who presented at an emergency department and are appropriate to be diverted to a Sobering Center.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ·Independent Living Systems ·McAlister Institute
Asthma Remediation	Asthma Remediation helps provide physical modifications to a home environment that are necessary to ensure the health, welfare, and safety of the individual, or enable the individual to function in the home and without which acute asthma episodes could result in the need for emergency services and hospitalization.
